Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) Outcomes 2019 (provisional)

EYFS Outcomes: Children are defined as having reached a **Good Level of Development** at the end of EYFS if they have achieved at least the expected level in the Early Learning Goals for the prime areas of learning - personal, social and emotional, physical development and communication and language and the ELGs in the specific areas of mathematics and literacy.

In 2019 **75%** of pupils achieved a **Good Level of Development**, which is above LA (68%) and National Expectations (72%).

Phonics Outcomes 2019

Phonics: The phonics screening is a check of pupils' phonic knowledge. It is administered in Year 1 and monitors the percentage of pupils who have made the expected progress.

Pupils who do not meet the standard in Year 1 re-take the check in Year 2.

The threshold for expected progress in 2019 was 32 out of 40.

In 2019 91% of St. Joseph's pupils achieved the threshold for phonics, which is above LA (79%) and National Expectations (82%).
