Differences: Boys and Girls	<p>To introduce the concept of male and female gender stereotypes.</p> <p>To identify the differences between male and females.</p>	<p>Understand that some people have fixed ideas about what boys and girls can do.</p> <p>Describe the difference between male and female babies.</p>	<p>similar, different, sex, gender roles, stereotypes, boys, girls, male, female, private parts, penis, vagina.</p>	<p>PSHE: Recognising things in common and difference</p>	<p>Talk to your child about the differences between boys and girls.</p> <p>Try to challenge any stereotypes e.g. why boys can't play with dolls? Why girls can't play football?</p>

<p>Differences: Male and Female</p>	<p>To explore some of the differences between males and females and to understand why this is part of the life cycle.</p>	<p>Describe some of the differences between male and female animals.</p> <p>Understand that making a new life needs a male and a female.</p>	<p>similar, different, sex, gender roles, stereotypes, boys, girls, male, female, private parts, penis, vagina</p>	<p>PSHE: Recognising things in common and difference; Growing older</p> <p>Science: Notice animals have offspring.</p>	<p>Talk about the differences between male and female animals e.g. why do cows have udders?</p>
<p>Naming body parts</p>	<p>To focus on sexual difference and naming body parts.</p>	<p>Describe the physical differences between males and females.</p> <p>Name the male and female body parts.</p>	<p>similar, different, sex, gender roles, stereotypes, boys, girls, male, female, private parts, penis, vagina</p>	<p>PSHE: Growing older; naming body parts.</p>	<p>Be confident using the correct terminology when discussing body parts with the children and not substitute them as these can often trivialise or demean what you are discussing.</p>
