Outdoors

The varied terrain within the 84-acre grounds offers many opportunities for lesson and curriculum support. Each programme is delivered by fully-qualified staff and has a range of different aims and outcomes centred on the children's learning and development.



- At Hudnall Park skilled and qualified staff deliver 30 different activities linked to National Curriculum subjects, from science, geography and environmental studies to numeracy, literacy and art.
- Learning outside the classroom: educational and adventurous activities for primary and secondary school students through hands-on learning and discovery.
- Programmes are also designed to improve children's and young people's personal and social skills which are essential for managing relationships at home and at school.





To complement the outdoor education there are also more adventurous activities such as ropes courses, zip wires and an obstacle course which, along with activities such as camp fire building, archery and orienteering, are designed to build confidence, physical skills and communication and team-working skills.

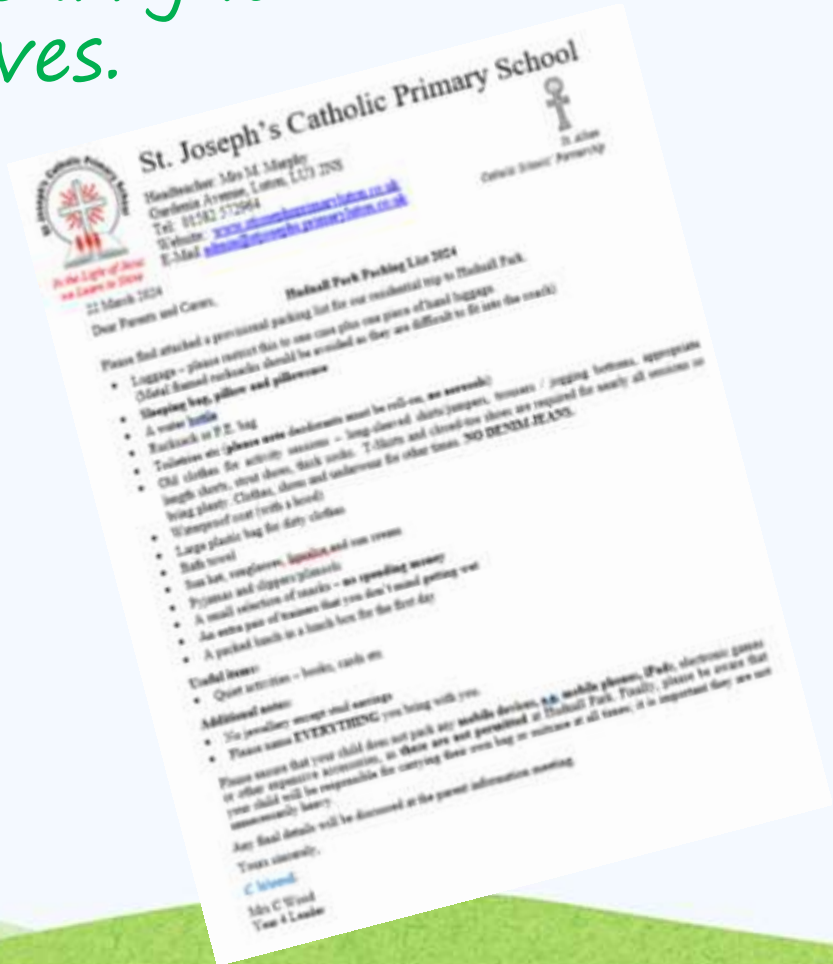
